Iconic around the world

To celebrate the 40th anniversary of the EM77 vacuum jug, it is being launched in an elegant finish that echoes back to the classic steel version and reaches into the future. The colour range of the special edition is matt, metallic black, dark brown and dark blue.



Erik Magnussen trained as a ceramist at the School of Applied Arts and Design in Copenhagen and graduated with a silver medal in 1960. He designed his iconic vacuum jug in 1977, combining the perfect classic cylindrical form with outstanding functionality.
